Our highly skilled and dedicated staff, with support from our NHS partners, are experts at maximising the wellbeing of those living with us.

The unique on-site partnership between Chailey Heritage Foundation and Chailey Clinical Services, part of the Sussex

Community NHS Foundation Trust, puts a wide range of highly specialised services on the doorstep of Futures residential bungalows.

These include on-call only nurses, speech and language therapists, physiotherapists, occupational therapists and rehabilitation engineers.

Informal learning and wellbeing

Our residential bungalows offer a diverse range of activities for the residents to participate in, including a fully accessible garden for outdoor games and activities and indoors sensory areas for therapy and relaxation.

We are also proud to offer eye-gaze technology in our bungalows. Eye-gaze is an eye-driven communication device where a user controls

a computer through eye tracking. This has been a real game changer for many of our residents with communication difficulties and it can be a gateway to further independence and can also enrich lives.

Furthermore, our residents can also access our modern on-site facilities such as the Leisure & Skills Centre (LSC) with its fully accessible gym and spa,

the hydrotherapy pool and the immersive space and sports hall of the Dream Centre, as well as art, music sessions and more!

We are constantly amazed at the diverse range of enriching activities young adults choose to participate in, both on-site and off-site.

"Staff respect the nature and character of each of the residents, they're all looked at as individuals and they're cared for as individuals, they will allow them to risk take and to develop their independence so that they are given the space and the time and the ability to do what they want to do."

Providing stimulating activities and enabling life choices

Our dedicated Activity Coordinator for Futures plans weekly timetables around therapy and appointments to incorporate use of the on-site activities and outings in the community and further afield.

The young persons' interests and preferences are taken into consideration as well as being offered new opportunities and experiences like silent discos, concerts or trips to London!

We also give our residents

a chance to be active in the community. This helps give them a different perspective on life; this can include volunteering, fundraising or even work experience.

Our links with several local colleges enables young adults to continue their learning journey.

Through many rich and diverse life experiences, young adults living with us are able to discover who they are and what they really enjoy doing.
