How we use your information

Chailey Heritage Foundation uses your information to better understand your needs and provide you with information. We may also use your information to contact you or to provide you with information we think would be of particular interest. We will always give you the opportunity to opt out of receiving such information, normally via an opt out tick box on a form.

Cookie usage information

What is a cookie?

Cookies are small text files that are placed on your computer by websites that you visit. They are widely used in order to make websites work, or work more efficiently, as well as to provide information to the owners of the site.

How we use cookies

We use cookies to control how the pages look and to remember your preferences and choices. They are also used to control access to secure parts of the website and for some advanced functionality. We also use cookies via Google Analytics in order to track the usage of our site. It is important to aid in improving and maintaining our website. When someone visits our website we collect standard internet log information and details of visitor behaviour patterns. We do this to find out things such as the number of visitors to the various parts of the site. We collect this information in a way which does not identify anyone. We may also use targeting cookies to collect information on users' browsing habits, which may also include your use of social media sites e.g. Facebook, which will be used to show relevant information to users elsewhere on the internet. In limited circumstances the information collected may be used to remarket to users.
